




Creative Arts Week 2018

Nursery & Reception

Stagecoach will be visiting Nursery and Reception to provide a workshop for the children using story, dance and drama. We are looking at the books 'The Dot', 'Press Here' and 'Lots of Dots'. The children will be learning about the artist Kandinsky and Aboriginal art and how these artists used circles in their work.



Year 1

Freshwater Theatre Company will be visiting school to run a workshop on the Great Fire of London. Year 1 will be following up this workshop by creating landscapes of the Great Fire with a combination of collage and chalks.



Year 2

Year 2 will be looking at portraits, linking to their IPC unit, 'People from the Past' comparing historical figures and their portraits.

Artist focus will be Picasso and Andy Warhol.



As part of their textile work the children will be doing collaborative circle on both large and small hoops.



Year 3

On Friday the children will be taking part in a Stone Age workshop re-enacting life in the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age linked to their IPC topic 'Scavengers and Settlers'. The children will be going hunting in their drama workshop, so watch out for spears! The children will also be creating their own cave paintings using a variety of tools inspired by the workshop.



Year 4


On Tuesday the children will be taking part in Egyptian Cartouche painting. Year 4 will also be going on a Dinosaur Adventure to the Oxford Natural History Museum 4P & 4S on Thursday and 4D on Friday. The children will have a tour of the museum and a talk from one of the curators, then go off around the museum finding facts and having opportunities to sketch some of the displays.

There will be a range of other exciting creative activities throughout the week such as making dinosaurs out of play-doh, collages, dinosaur skeletons out of pasta and Land art dinosaurs in the style of the artist Andy Goldsworthy.



Year 5

On Tuesday the children will be getting creative with Lego at our Lego Workshop taking over the Key Stage 2 hall. We will also be looking at the Cubist art movement and Japanese paintings, with the children creating wax resist pictures. On Friday, following Diwali on Thursday we will study the story of Diwali and create outdoor Rangoli chalk patterns, along the long path between the Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 buildings. This links to the IPC unit, 'They See the World Like This'



Year 6

We are looking forward to visiting the MAD Museum in Stratford on Wednesday to explore mechanical art and design. We have challenges to complete before, during and after our visit.

We will also be exploring Islamic art and creating geometric patterns. In English we will be studying the life of Monet and writing biographies. We will be creating Mayan masks following research and design linked to our IPC topic.
