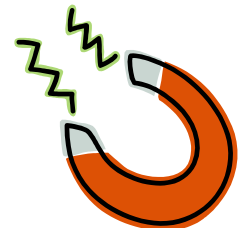
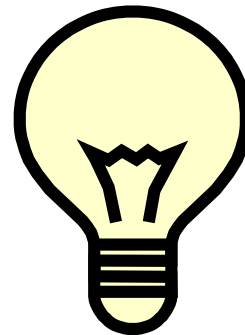

- Please ensure a letter is sent to your child's class teacher if your child is not able to take part due to medical reasons

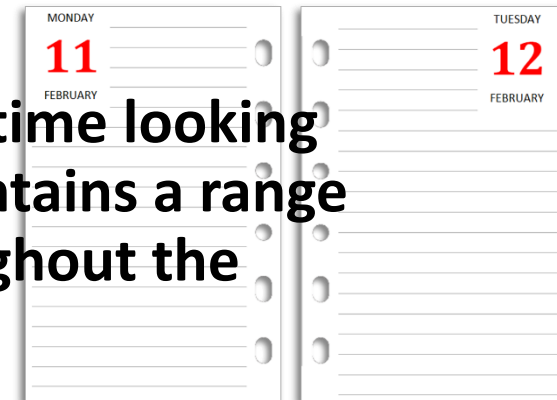


Home School Organiser
