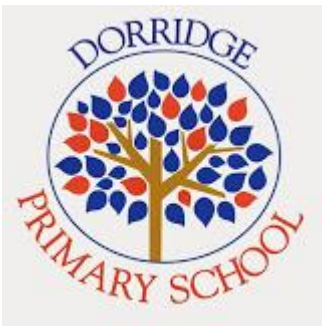

# English

# PE

- Year 5 and 6 are predominantly the years where pupils get to represent their school.

Then tap 'Continue'

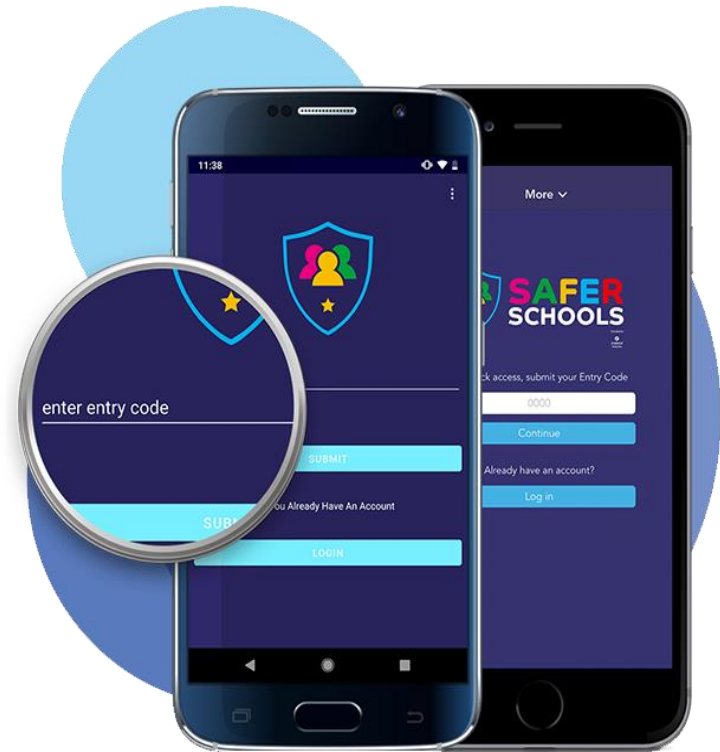

# A Few More Things
