NURSERY UNIFORM

Royal blue sweatshirt

White short-sleeved polo shirt with embroidered school logo* (plain white polo shirt optional)

A pair of black pumps with velcro fastening, kept in school in a navy/red drawstring pump bag*

A change of clothes also to be kept in Nursery in their drawstring pump bag* on their peg

Children are permitted to wear grey skirt, pinafore, trousers, shorts or culottes

Alternatively, they can wear jeans, chinos, leggings, joggers, skirts or shorts

Book bag with school logo*

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Winter

EYFS & KS1 White short-sleeved polo shirt with embroidered school logo* (plain white polo shirt optional)

Grey skirt, pinafore, trousers, shorts or culottes. Grey, navy or black tights or grey knee length or ankle socks

KS2 White shirt and school tie*

Grey skirt, pinafore, trousers, shorts or culottes

Grey, navy or black tights or grey knee length or ankle socks

Summer

KS1 & KS2 to be worn during Summer Term and Autumn Term until October Half Term

White short-sleeved polo shirt with embroidered school logo* (plain white polo shirt optional)

Red and white gingham check, short sleeved dress or playsuit and white ankle socks

or white short-sleeved plain blouse and grey skirt, pinafore, trousers, shorts or culottes

To be worn with:

Navy jumper or cardigan with a red stripe* (compulsory item)

Black shoes

Rain jacket with school logo* (optional) or coat

PE KIT

Reception - To be kept in school in a navy/red drawstring pump bag*

KS1 & KS2 - Years 1-6 must come to school dressed in their PE Kit on their PE day (see timetable)

Reception, KS1 & KS2 To be worn to school on timetabled PE days

Plain navy PE shorts or skirt and navy/red PE T-shirt* (compulsory item)

EYFS - A pair of black pumps with a velcro fastening

Year 1 – 6 A pair of trainers

Navy hoodie with school logo* or plain navy hoodie or navy long sleeve games shirt* (discontinued)

Navy PE joggers/navy leggings (optional)

KS2 A pair of trainers to be kept in school for the 'Daily Mile'

No jewellery may be worn in School. However, a watch and one small plain stud in each ear is permitted.

Red, navy or white hair accessories, appropriate size, no large bows.

Hair art, zig zags, tramlines or coloured dye are not permitted.
