

## Eco-Council agenda for the summer term

### **Week 1**

#### Hedgehogs

Learn about hedgehogs and how to help them (food, hedgehog homes). Find a good place on our site for a hedgehog gate and discuss setting up homes

### **Week 2**

#### Pollinators

Learn about the job of pollinators. Weed and tidy the flower beds to welcome more pollinators to our school grounds. Record insect species

### **Week 3**

#### KS1 pond

Learn about pond life. Check the health of the KS1 pond and record wildlife

### **Week 4**

#### Compost

Learn about compost and how to make it. Move compost from the compost bins in KS1 veg garden onto flower beds around school

### **Week 5**

#### Wildlife lawn patch

Learn about 'No Mow May'. Identify an area on the KS2 field which will not be mowed. Observe wildlife species and return in September to record any improvements in wildlife numbers

### **Week 6**

#### Trees

Learn about how trees help us. Book out the ipads. Identify and map trees on the school site
